+	You	had		stopped	before me.
-	She	had	not	gone	to school.
-	We	had	not	left.	
?	Had	you		arrived?	
?	Had	they		eaten	dinner?

- A 1. You'd gone before I woke up.
- A 2.1 thought (realized) I'd made a mistake.



- 3. Yes, but he left early. (simple past)
- No, He had already left. (past perfect)
